



## VALID PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS

The following documents may be used as identification for purposes of voting in Kansas:

- Driver's license or ID card issued by Kansas or by another state
- U.S. passport
- Student ID card from an accredited post-secondary education institution in Kansas
- U.S. military ID
- Employee badge or identification document issued by a government office
- Concealed carry of handgun license issued by Kansas or by another state
- Public assistance identification card issued by a government office

A voter age 65 or older may use an expired document.

## 2012 ELECTION DATES

### City Primary Election-February 28, 2012 (If needed)

Advance Voting begins February 8, 2012 and ends at noon February 27, 2012.

### City General Election-April 3, 2012

Advance Voting begins March 14, 2012 and ends at noon April 2, 2012.

### National/State/County Primary Election-August 7, 2012

Advance Voting begins July 18, 2012 and ends at noon August 6, 2012.

### National/State/County General Election-November 6, 2012

Advance Voting begins October 17, 2012 and ends at noon November 5, 2012

## **VOTE EARLY!**

Anyone can ADVANCE VOTE starting 20 days before every election!  
Pick the method that works the best for you.

### **- In person in the County Clerk's Office -**

Voting hours are 8:00 am to 4:30 pm Monday-Friday  
(extended hours may be available for National & State elections)  
ID must be shown when voting  
(Hassle Free and Saves Postage!)

OR

### **- Mail Ballot -**

Call the County Clerk's Office or go to our website ([www.miamicountyks.org](http://www.miamicountyks.org)) Select Elections and print an "Application for Advance Voting Ballot"

Mail or fax the completed application to the County Clerk's Office

Include a copy of your Photo ID with your application

After marking your ballot place it in the return envelope and sign

Affix the appropriate postage and mail it to the County Clerk's Office

You can return your own ballot in person to the County Clerk's Office or designate someone else to return your ballot for you. The person you designate has an affirmation to sign too!

OR

### **- Permanent Advance -**

You must have a Permanent Disability to qualify for Permanent Advance.

Call the County Clerk's Office to have an application mailed to you

Include a copy of your Photo ID with your application

Mail or fax the completed application to the County Clerk's Office

After marking your ballot place it in the return envelope and sign

Affix the appropriate postage and mail it to the County Clerk's Office

You can return your own ballot in person to the County Clerk's Office or designate someone else to return or mail your ballot for you. The person you designate has an affirmation to sign too!

### **Be an Election Worker!**

The Requirements:

1. Registered to vote in Miami County as either a Republican or a Democrat
2. Willing to work long hours. Election School is paid and is a minimum of 2 hours and Election Day is a minimum of 12 hours.
3. Willing to travel to polling places located within the county. Sometimes on short notice.
4. Election Day wages at the polls for Judges/Clerks \$100.00, Supervising Judge \$120.00.
