~ The State Treasurer's Office has over \$200 million of unclaimed property waiting to be claimed by both businesses as well as individual Kansans. Unclaimed property is inactive savings and checking accounts, un-cashed checks, stock shares, mutual funds and bonds, dividend checks, insurance proceeds, royalty payments, utility deposits and, in some cases, safe deposit box contents. We are currently holding a total of \$749,494 for individuals and businesses in Miami County. In the coming weeks we will make a special effort to return this unclaimed property through a program called Back to Business. ~
